

## Edit as new and close match


When adding a new item, sometimes there is not an exact match (searching both the AspenCat database and doing a Z39.50 search). Rather than making an original record, it is easier to start with a close match.

A close match will match on format (that is, if cataloging a DVD, start with a bib record for DVD). Ideally you will have other match points (such as title, author, subject headings).


## If you find a close match in AspenCat

Example: Looking for "The Red Skelton Collection"; 2 DVD, 2005; contents: "Red Skelton's Funny Faces II - Skelton is joined by world-renowned mime artist Marcel Marceau in recreating some of Red's funniest routines and exciting new skits. Red Skelton's Funny Faces III - Packed with laughter and memorable characters, this special features Red in more hilarious sketches and pantomime. Red Skelton's Freddy The Freeloader's Christmas Dinner - A touching, music-filled holiday tale featuring Vincent Price and Imogene Coca with plenty of laughs for the whole family. Red Skelton's Royal Command Performance - America's wackiest court jester gets silly with Britain's royal family at London's Royal Albert Hall."


- 1. Locate a close match in AspenCat
- 2. Click on the down Arrow on the Edit button




3. Select Edit as New (Duplicate)



4. Remove tagfields 001, 003, 040 (just click on the minus sign by tag field description



5. Click on the ellipses for 008



6. Review data, change as needed (possibly the date fields)



- 7. Click OK to save changes
- 8. Continue reviewing fields on the "0" tab, deleting or changing data as needed. Look especially at the 010,020, 022, 024, 028 fields. As these are unique identifiers you will either need to delete or change the data.
- 9. Review tag fields by tab numbers; change data as needed.
- 10. Pay special attention to 300 Physical Description; adjust as needed
- 11. When you are done "Save the record".
- 12. System will suspect duplicate record. Click on Save as New Record



13. Add your item.

14. Click on "Labeled MARC"



15. Review data – see if anything needs changed.

If you cannot find a close match in AspenCat, but find one through Z39.50 search.

Import the record and then go through the same steps as above.
